



Welcome to the Monday Night Trivia Challenge presented by Pepsi and Seasons Grille & Sports Lounge! This is a weekly competition that puts the best trivia players in the greater Bangor area against one another for weekly prizes, bragging rights, and the crown of the best in trivia for our overall winners.

How the Monday Trivia Challenge Works...

Every Monday from 7:30-8:30 p.m. at Seasons we will host trivia (unless posted otherwise on the Seasons Facebook Page) with great trivia action. You and your team will compete in the challenge for weekly prizes and a chance to win the overall championship every quarter year.

The trivia consists of three rounds of play each night, consisting of five questions in each round. Round 1 questions will be worth one point, Round 2 will be for two points each, and Round 3 will have a value of three points for every correct answer. Then there will be three questions called the Tricky Three, worth five points apiece consisting of difficult questions for you and your team to try. The final question is called the Risky Business question will allow your team to bid any number of points you have acquired ranging from every point to none. This allows you to bet any variation of your points and gives the team a chance to either steal a win or stave off the competition if you're brave enough. At the end of the contest we will tally all the points and give out prizes for the top three teams in the contest for the week.

To answer the questions, you just write down the answers on your score sheet for the corresponding question in pen and then the host will come around and either give you the right or wrong check mark. You will not be penalized for a wrong answer in the contest, outside of the Risky Business question to close the contest. So, feel free to take a guess and give yourself a shot to gain some points.

To add to the intrigue for the winner of the weekly contest, we will offer the team that takes the top spot to either risk their guaranteed prize for a chance at a better option by spinning our wheel. Make sure you think about the decision because you have a shot at a better prize or gaining an extra point for the grand championship, but you also have a chance to get stuck with a random, less than savory selection from our prize Bin of Misery for the week.

Teams can consist of one to six players on each team, but each squad will have to maintain the same team name for the duration of the competition. You may have other people at the table

for your meal, but we ask you to please not abuse the competition to make it unfair to other people competing. You may also play as a one-person team, or a duo, or so on...the choice is up to you. Along with a prize for winning (predicated on your decision on electing for the Spin-Off or not), the team will receive one special t-shirt each weekly victory honoring your win!

We also ask teams not to use the help of a cell phone, tablet, laptop, or anything that could be used to look up the answer via the internet. If you know the answer, please also keep it to yourself as not to ruin it for the rest of the teams playing in the game. Teams caught cheating will not be eligible to win and will also not gain any points for participation.

How to win the Trivia Grand Championship...

The Monday Night Trivia Challenge will culminate each quarter of the year by awarding the Trivia Grand Championship to the overall winner for trivia excellence. There will be a point system given out depending on success and also consistency. Each team will receive a single point for each trivia night they attend. If a team comes in third place, along with a prize for placing, they will also receive an additional point for the week. A team finishing in second for the week will garner two extra points, and a team in first overall will get three points. For example, if a team comes three weeks in a row and finishes in first twice and third place another time, they will receive three participation points, six points for coming in first twice, and one more point for a third place finish for a total of 10 points in three weeks. You can also gain points by winning them in the Spin-Off. After the competition wraps up each quarter, the team that holds the most total points will be named the Trivia Grand Champion! The top three teams in the race at the end will also be put into random drawing for a Grand Prize. So the top team gets the honor of being the best, but it not completely guaranteed the grand prize, always giving you a chance to be a big winner!
